What follows are a few things we need that most venues provide anyway, but it's good to get them down in writing. Don't worry, no-one has a pet dog you need to house in their own dressing room, and we have no colour preference when it comes to coated chocolate sweets! We'll eat them all...

- Please take note of our Technical Rider (separate PDF).
- Payment conditions must be agreed by the band, venue and promotor in writing prior to performance.
- If any ticketing rules (minimum tickets sold, allowed number of guests, etc) apply these must be made known to the band prior to confirmation of the gig date.
- The venue should provide clear access for load in/out and information on closest parking and local parking restrictions.
- The venue should make it known if any hospitality (food & drink) is provided for the band. If not, please provide information as to where food and drink can be bought in the local area.
- The venue MUST provide secure storage for band gear and valuables.
- If accommodation is required (and the venue provides it) please provide accommodation for four people which includes parking and a secure storage location for band gear.
- If accommodation is required (and the venue does not provide it) please provide information on nearby hotels. In this case, help with accommodation costs would be agreed beforehand in writing.
